Hey Kids,

Did you plant any flowers or fruits or vegetables this year? Have you noticed the different colors of flowers and leaves while on a walk?

Bring in some of the colors of summer by picking flowers, from your garden and yard, or by permission of other garden owners, and put them in a one of a kind vase made by you!

Recycled Vase

You will need:

- ☀️ A clean, dry, glass jar
- ☀️ Yarn (any color or variety of colors)
- ☀️ Scissors
- ☀️ White glue
- ☀️ Table covering (to protect from a glue spill)

Gather your supplies and cover your workspace. Cut strips of yarn about as long as your arm (ask for help with cutting if you need it!). Starting below the lip of the jar, put glue on the sides of the jar covering about 1" at a time. Wrap yarn around the jar, over the glue, and gently press into the glue. Repeat until you reach about half way down the jar; turn the jar upside down and continue to glue and wrap yarn. Stop when you reach the base of the jar. Turn jar right side up and set aside to dry. It's now ready to hold water and flowers!

Have fun with this project and make more to share as gifts to brighten someone's day!

EASY FRUIT SMOOTHIE BOWLS



Ingredients

- 1 c Greek yogurt, plain or any complementary flavor
 - 1 c frozen fruit, any fruit or fruit blend
 - 1 T honey or agave nectar
- Optional toppings or mix-ins: crispy rice cereal, crushed graham crackers, fruit slices, granola, mini chocolate chips, nuts, sprinkles, etc.

Directions

Ask an adult for help using a blender. Add all ingredients to the blender and blend until smooth. Pour into bowls. Enjoy as is or add toppings or mix-ins. Yield: 4 servings

☀ Mix it up and try these combinations!

Blueberry Pie = lemon yogurt + frozen blueberries + crushed graham crackers

Forest Berry = strawberry yogurt + frozen mixed berries + granola

Peach Melba = vanilla yogurt + frozen raspberries + peach slices

Tropical = mango yogurt + frozen pineapple + shredded coconut and banana slices

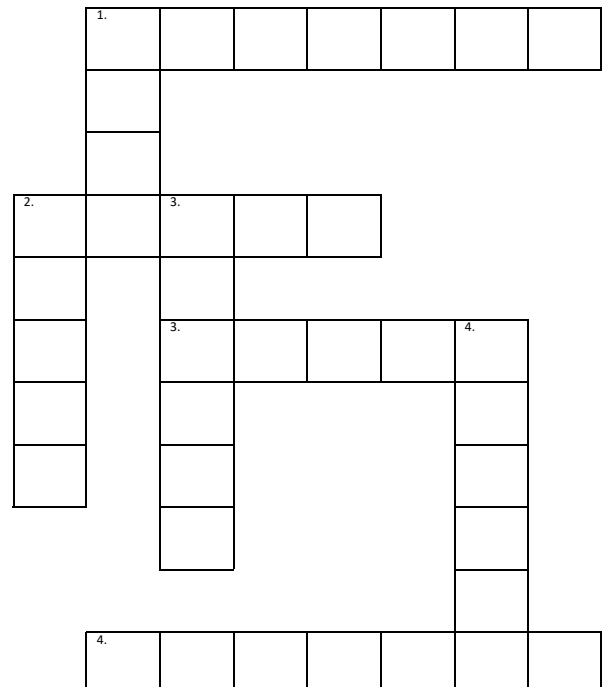
